

What Are Demodex Mites?

Demodex mites are parasites that live inside hair follicles, they are relatives of ticks, spiders, scorpions and other arachnids. In the animal kingdom, there are many species of mites, and the Demodex family contains 65. Of those, only two reside on human skin – Demodex folliculorum and Demodex brevis.

65 species are known2 species live on humans

1. Demodex Folliculorum


- approx. 0.3mm in length

- approx. 0.2mm in length
- lives in sebaceous glands

Anyone can have mites. However, there are some factors that increase the likelihood and severity of a Demodex infestation.



Demodex can be responsible for many issues within hair follicles and skin, it's sometimes hard to tell what to look out for. When an overpopulation of mites are found in the skin, it can cause different types of skin disorder. Below are some of the signs and symptoms linked to Demodex mites.

Mammals

Microscopic mites can cause mange in animals. Mange is a type of skin disease caused by parasitic mites. Mites also can infect plants, birds, and reptiles.

Mange includes mite-associated skin disease in domestic animals (cats and dogs), in livestock (such as sheep scab), and in wild animals (for example, coyotes, cougars, and bears). Since mites belong to the arachnid subclass Acari (also called Acarina), another term for mite infestation is acariasis.

If a dog goes to the vet with a skin problem, one of the first tests they will do is for Demodex mites- so why are mites on humans not treated with the same awareness?

The Garden Concept

Treating mites is a fundamental pre-treatment to skin issues.

The role of mites in our skin is same as the role of the pest in the garden.

The pests live in the soil (like mites in your skin) and eat all the water and fertiliser that you are giving your plants (like oils and hair products).


Figure 4: Larva of D. folliculorum.




Stopping environmental cross-transfer

- 1. Demodex mites are a permanent fixture on the majority of the population. Skin to skin contact with other people can transfer mites from one person to another.
- 2. They live outside the body for days and shared towels and pillows are another method of transmission.
- 3. The current Demodex mite research approach is focused on reducing symptoms during the trial periods (mostly 2-4 weeks), not on killing all mites. Therefore, the most resilient mites stay alive and reproduce. This results in a relapse.
- 4. After a few rounds, mites do not respond to the treatments anymore. All mites should be eliminated to have lasting relief.







Demodex Defence Cleanser (DDC)

For use on the scalp, face, and body to help skin become a hostile environment for Demodex mites. For the best results, use in conjunction with Ungex Demodex sprays.

How to Use:

- 1. Read the 'Direction for Use' on the product label.
- 2. At night, apply cleanser to the skin and lather.
- 3. Rinse thoroughly after application with warm water.
- 4. Before exiting the shower, let cool water run over the skin.
- 5. Avoid products like conditioners, lotions, and moisturisers.

Did You Know?

Most people lower their skin's ability to protect them by stripping their skin and overusing cleansers, especially the face and scalp areas, further giving Demodex an advantage? To help fix this, only use the cleanser when there is dirt to remove from the skin.

Notes:

- · Suitable for both skin and hair.
- Avoid cleanser if your skin is not dirty.
- 'Dirt' can be defined by an unpleasant odour, cosmetics, air pollution, etc.
- · When skin is clean, shower with plain water only to control oil, massaging the skin as you go.
- If skin becomes dry, try reducing the frequency of use or apply organic cold-pressed extra-virgin coconut oil to introduce some moisture without feeding mites.

Important:

- · Cleansers alone are not enough to eradicate mites.
- For complete Demodex elimination, bundles or kits are required.









Demodex Hair Tonic (DHT)

Helps control the density of Demodex mites on the surface of the scalp and soothes itchy or irritated skin. It contains hair growth properties for use exclusively on the scalp to support the treatment and maintenance of mite populations. For best results, use in conjunction with Ungex Demodex sprays.

How to Use:

- 1. Read the 'Direction for Use' on the product label.
- 2. Shake before each use.
- 3. Use on damp scalp.
- 4. Spray tonic evenly using clean fingertips to spread and massage in an up and down motion.
- 5. Do not rinse.

Did You Know?

DHT is an optional product in the 'Ungex Care Plan' and although it is recommended for use at night, it may be used in the morning as well for those with special cases of extreme hair loss, and with the advice of a Demodex consultant.

Skin Demodex Treatment (SDT)

Hit mites where it hurts by using SDT nightly to aid in eliminating Demodex mites as they come to the surface of the skin and gradually reduce populations by repeated exposure.

How to Use:

- 1. Spray problem areas directly.
- 2. Use every night before bed.
- 3. Do not rinse.

Hint:

Those with sensitive skin, severe symptoms or are treating areas such as the lash line may need to introduce the product slowly by diluting with purified water and gradually increasing the strength. In case you experience this please do the following and contact your Demodex consultant directly to ensure you are using correctly.

Recommended Ratios:

Sensitive:

50/50 mix product with water and gradually increase the ratio.

Extremely Sensitive:

1st week 2 parts product to 10 parts water 2nd week 4/10 3rd week 7/10 4th week full strength

Pro-Demodex Treatment (PDT)

Highly concentrated PDT helps target mites on contact when used in daily/nightly routine. Also suitable to stop cross transfer when applied to fabrics that come into contact with affected areas (towels, pillows, etc.). Suitable for use to help prevent mites within the home and clinic.

How to Use:

- 1. Spray problem areas directly.
- 2. Use every night before bed.
- 3. Do not rinse.

Hint:

A little bit of PDT goes a long way. Mites live off your skin for several hours so changing your pillowcase nightly and any other items that come into contact with your skin may reduce cross transfer.

If in doubt, contact your Demodex consultant directly to ensure you are using correctly.

Did You Know?

High Frequency Instrument (HFI)

The HFI is a recommended technology that can be used in conjunction with Ungex products to speed up the process of your treatment. Not only does it host a lot of benefits, but it also compliments your 'Ungex Care Plan' by better penetrating Ungex products onto the skin as well as eliminating mites.

This instrument is suitable for use externally over the scalp, face, and body. It is advised that this is not available for purchase from Ungex directly.



How to Use:

- 1. Read the manufacturer's manual before use.
- 2. Clean and sterilise the electrode before use with PDT or SDT.
- 3. Switch on and insert the appropriate attachment.
- Glide on or around problem areas in circular motions, not leaving in one spot for longer than 10 seconds.
- **5.** Adjust the intensity of the frequency to your personal preference.
- 6. May use for at least 10 minutes at a time.
- 7. Adjust the intensity to 0 before switching off and remove the attachment.
- 8. Sterilise with PDT or SDT after use.

Tips & Tricks:

There will be a sharp smell created by ozone that is normal and is not a sign of a problem. It can be helpful to practice on the back of your hands to get a feel of the machine before use.

How to Use:

Step 1. Demodex Defence Cleanser (DDC) As required

- · Do not overuse cleanser.
- Does not need to be used every night unless there are visible signs of dirt.
- If the cleanser is not required, cleanse the skin and scalp with water only.

Step 2. Demodex Hair Tonic (DHT) Every night

· Spray on the scalp every night.

Step 3. High-Frequency Instrument (HFI) Recommended

- · Follow the direct method of application.
- · Use once a week up-to every night.

Step 4. Skin Demodex Treatment (SDT) & Pro Demodex Treatment (PDT) Every night

 PDT is our strongest anti-Demodex solution and SDT serves as the milder version. Both sprays can be used interchangeably for the skin and environment, however, those with sensitive skin may prefer to start with SDT and work their way up to PDT to help reduce any die-off symptoms.

Environmental Cross-transfer:

Demodex can transfer from the skin onto things in the environment through physical contact. It is important to reduce cross-transfer as much as possible and avoid repeat use of objects that come into contact with us daily, like towels, hairbrushes, pillowcases, etc.

To combat this, follow one or more of these options:

- · Leave fabrics in the sun for a few hours each day.
- Avoid repeating use of items for at least 52 hours.
- Spray bedding and pillowcases with SDT or PDT nightly before bed.

Tips & Tricks:

- · All products are suitable for use over the entire body (except DHT).
- All Ungex products should be used on damp skin/scalp.
- All Ungex products are required to be used in the protocol, although the most important role is the PDT/SDT spray.
- No other products should be used for the duration of treatment. If this is unavoidable, we strongly suggest that other products be used in the morning.
- If skin becomes dry and you know that you are not over-cleansing, try using organic, cold-pressed and extra-virgin coconut oil to introduce some moisture without feeding Demodex.
- · The best time to use all Ungex products is at night before bed.
- · Shake bottles before use.

Did You Know?

The Ungex protocol is one of the first fully developed treatments that is aimed at Demodex mites in human skin and is not symptoms specific. Ungex natural based products can be adapted to use in all areas, ages, and skin types.

STOP BAD HABITS

- Reduce the consumption of fried and greasy food.
- · Avoid sharing items that come in direct contact with the skin.
- · Reduce sedentary lifestyle, smoking, and alcohol consumption.
- Reduce any stress and pressure that may impact the immune system.

FOLLOW GOOD HABITS

- · Rinse skin in warm water, then finish with cool water.
- Stay hydrated, exercise regularly, and take some time to relax.
- Optimise your sleep routine to ensure your body has had plenty of rest.






